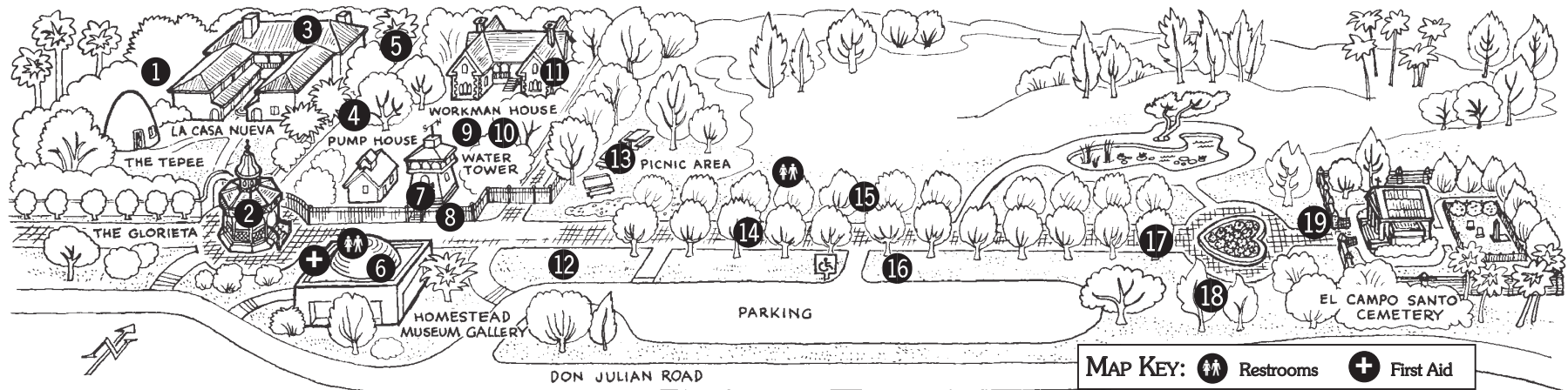
12 Hollywood Tales with Sherri Snyder & Karie Bible
